

### **2019 Israel Study Tour** Oct. 19-30, 2019

We are excited to offer this study opportunity in biblical culture and history. This is an opportunity to study Biblical Cultural Foundations during our First Term Enhanced program, then take a hands on study tour in the footsteps of Jesus. This tour will take you beyond the typical tourist sites to explore the geographical archaeological sites, the cultural context, and the historical background of the text of scripture. To access these sites, tour members can expect 6-10 miles of rigorous hiking/climbing/walking during each day of the trip. Learning and experiencing the text will not be an end in itself, but will grow our relationship with the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob and deepen our call to live the text in our time and culture.

This tour will be led by Joe Mullet from Talmidim Studies in Sugar Creek, OH. Joe has been leading study tours in Israel since 2013 and has prepared this tour especially for SMBI students and alumni. He will be assisted by a native, Messianic Jewish guide.



All applications for the tour will be received. The 40 seats for the tour will first be given to First Term Enhanced students, then SMBI alumni with remaining seats awarded on a first-come-first-served basis. The priority application deadline for the tour is May 1. A passport is required with an expiration date of

Tour costs include transportation from SMBI, air travel, lodging, breakfast, lunch, and dinner, all site and entrance fees, guide services, taxes, and tips. Lodging is double occupancy in hotels with one night scheduled at a desert Bedouin camp. Cost is approx. \$3650/person.

To apply use the standard student application with a \$500 tour deposit. An additional \$1250 will be due May 1, \$1250 due June 1, and the balance due July 1, 2019. If applying only for the tour, you may use the tour application on the third page of this Monitor.

#### Housing Need

Over the past 42 years, God has provided in amazing ways for major campus renovations and staff housing. Numerous of these projects have faced additional challenges due to land limitations. For many years, SMBI has also rented two houses from the Asbury Methodist Parish, one of which is on the opposite side of busy Rt. 30 from the school. There is a possible opportunity to address the land issue, reduce the rental burden, and eliminate the safety hazards in crossing Rt. 30. Our administrator's family is also in need of more bedroom space as their family grows. The association is considering the purchase of a 17.7 acre property adjacent to the campus across Schoolhouse Road with a small house and some outbuildings. Further renovation or building would be required to completely resolve the housing situation. This property was appraised at \$232,000 but the owner is currently asking \$290,000. At this time, there is no formal agreement. Whether SMBI purchases this property or God leads us to address the housing need in some other fashion, it will take substantial financial resources. The association has identified this need as a priority and therefore designated a special fund for those who wish to contribute. Contributions may be sent to the institute office and designated as "Housing Fund." The association invites you to join them in prayer for God's leading, guidance, and provision in this opportunity and need.
